

Boarding and Compulsory Quarantine Arrangements for Persons Arriving at Hong Kong from Korea

(With effect from August 20, 2021)

Group B specified places (Medium-risk)		
Persons applicable:	Travellers who have stayed in Group B specified place(s), including Korea , on the day of boarding for/arrival at Hong Kong or during the 14 days before that day but have not stayed in Group A specified place(s) during the 21-day relevant period and who –	
	are Hong Kong residents, and who –	are Hong Kong residents or non-Hong Kong residents, and who –
	do not hold recognised vaccination record	have been fully vaccinated and hold recognised vaccination record*
Boarding requirement:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> (a) Present negative result proof of a polymerase chain reaction (PCR)-based nucleic acid test for COVID-19 conducted within 72 hours before the scheduled time of departure of the aircraft; and (b) Present confirmation of room reservation for 21 nights starting on the day of arrival in a designated quarantine hotel (DQH) 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> (a) Present a recognised vaccination record*; (b) Present negative result proof of a PCR-based nucleic acid test for COVID-19 conducted within 72 hours before the scheduled time of departure of the aircraft; and (c) Present confirmation of room reservation for 14 nights starting on the day of arrival in a DQH
Quarantine requirement:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> (a) Undergo compulsory quarantine for 21 days in a DQH; and (b) Undergo six tests during compulsory quarantine 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> (a) Undergo compulsory quarantine for 14 days in a DQH; (b) Undergo four tests during compulsory quarantine; (c) Self-monitor for the subsequent seven days; and (d) Undergo compulsory testing on the 16th and 19th days of arrival at Hong Kong (in a Community Testing Centre for the test on the 19th day)

* A vaccination record should include:

- (a) A **vaccination record in English or Chinese** issued by a healthcare institution or a relevant authority of the government of the place where the vaccine was administered, bearing the name of the relevant vaccinated traveller matching that in his/her valid travel document to show that:
 - (i) the relevant traveller has received dose(s) of COVID-19 vaccine and the date on which the last dose was administered; and

- (ii) the name of the vaccine administered; and
- (b) A **written confirmation in English or Chinese** issued by the healthcare institution or a relevant authority of the government of the place where the vaccine was administered, bearing the name of the relevant vaccinated traveller matching that in his/her valid travel document and setting out all of the above information **if the vaccination record is not in English or Chinese or does not contain all of the above information**. The said written confirmation should be presented together with the vaccination record.
